Putnam City Schools is approaching its centennial celebration, and a major part of that celebration will be a professionally produced hardcover book containing text and photos detailing the first 100 years of our favorite school district. The Putnam City Centennial History Book is being published by the Putnam City Schools Museum, with all proceeds above production costs dedicated to the museum's endowment. While pre-orders are now being taken for the book, its production will be expensive, and the museum committee is seeking donations to help underwrite the project.

Business and individual donors will be listed prominently in the book in three categories:

- Superintendent donors — those contributing \$5,000 or more;
- Principal donors — those contributing from \$1,000 to \$5,000; and
